

## PLAGIARISM

All research raises ethical issues. Ethical issues have the potential to impact at every stage of the research process. Let's discuss on research ethics in the context of publication. A research work either in form of thesis, book or research paper/article, should be free from Plagiarism.

What is Plagiarism? It is need of all researchers to know about them clearly. "Plagiarism is the act of taking another person's writing, conversation, song, or even idea and passing it off as your own. This includes information from web pages, books, songs, television shows, email messages, interviews, articles, artworks or any other medium. Whenever you paraphrase, summarize, or take words, phrases, or sentences from another person's work, it is necessary to indicate the source of the information within your paper using an internal citation. It is not enough to just list the source in a bibliography at the end of your paper. Failing to properly quote, cite or acknowledge someone else's words or ideas with an internal citation is plagiarism".

Anti-plagiarism software like – *iThenticate*, *Turnitin* and *Urkund* may be used for plagiarism checking of theses, publications, dissertations, projects and reports. It's but mandatory that Ph. D scholars submit their theses/ dissertations after ensuring that they are plagiarism free.

To avoid plagiarism, especially for students, following guidelines should be kept in mind.

1. Use citation wherever and whenever you use even a single word of someone else.
2. Laws or facts that have been accepted universally, like *Natyashastra* is written by Bhart muni don't need to be cited because everybody knows about them.
3. Sometimes plagiarism results in the research work unconsciously, e-g; you forgot to put inverted commas at one place or you missed one reference without knowing or you mixed your writings and words with that of someone else. To avoid such risks be very cautious from the start till the end. Write down the reference just below the line or paragraph you have taken from any secondary source.
4. Believe in quality work and research is all about quality and originality so don't worry about lengthy manuscripts. Write less but write well.
